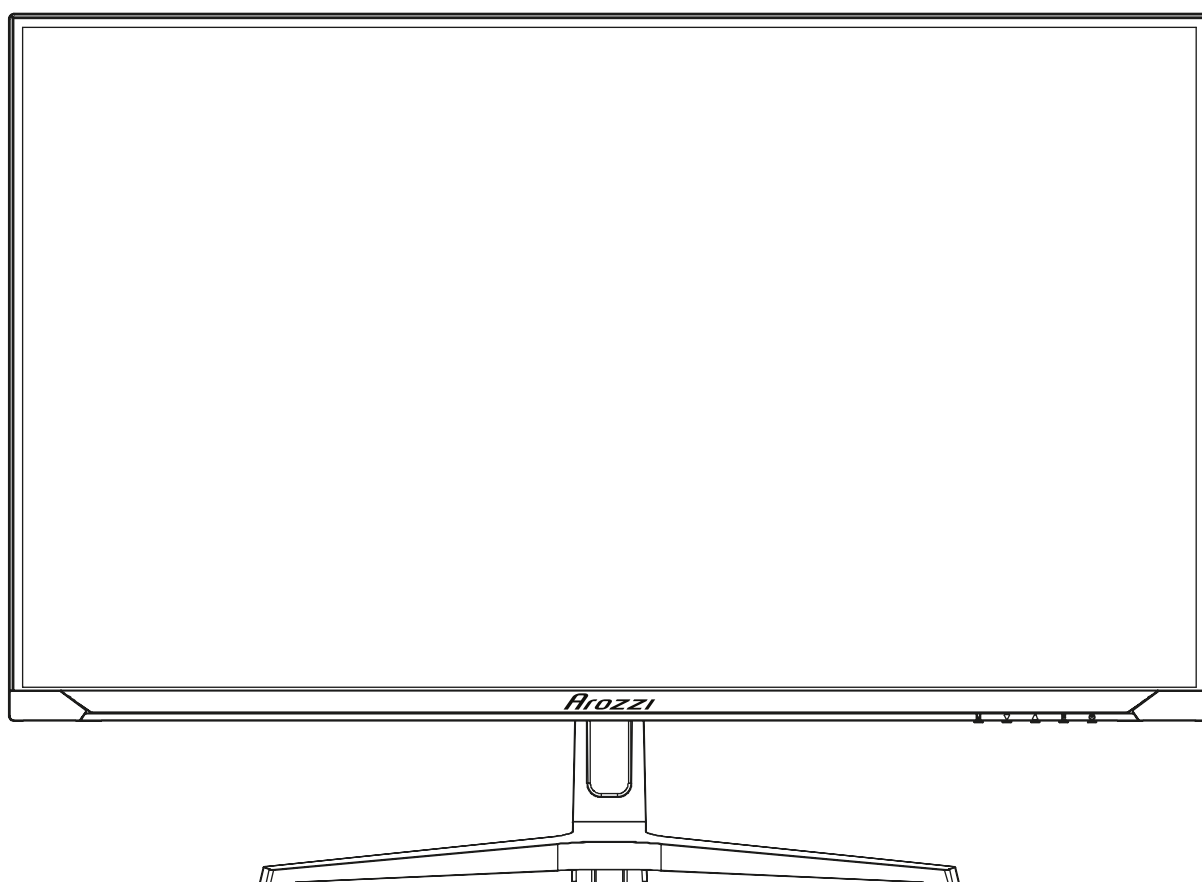

WARNINGS

POWER

- Only use the power unit provided to power the device.
- Check mains rating before plugging the power unit in.
- Do not pull on the cable to unplug the device.
- Turn Off the device before unplugging.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Keep the device away from rain and humidity to prevent risk of fire and electrocution.
- Do not introduce material (solid or liquid) inside. If this should accidentally occur, disconnect the device from power and have it inspected by qualified personnel.
- Keep the device away from children, to prevent accidental damage.
- Do not touch the device with wet hands to prevent electrical shock or mechanical damage.
- Do not use the device if it should fall or the external casing is damaged. Risk of electrocution if the device is used in such conditions.
- It is advisable to disconnect the device from power if the monitor is not used for a certain time.
- Never open the device. In all cases, contact Arozzi for repairs.

INSTALLATION PRECAUTIONS

- To prevent the device from overheating, arrange it in a position that allows the flow of air to enter through the slots in the casing.
- Do not install near sources of heat, such as radiators or hot air ducts.
- Slots and openings in the cabinet are provided for ventilation. These openings must not be blocked or covered: risk of fire, electrocution and mechanical failure.
- Keep away from direct sunlight.
- Do not use the device in presence of smoke, vapor, humidity, dust or intense vibrations.
- Do not install this device on an unstable surface, such as a wobbly or slanted table. The device could fall causing injury or mechanical failures.
- Do not install the device in a place where it could be exposed to humidity or water.
- Do not direct a jet of water onto the device: risk of fire, electrocution or mechanical failure.
- Stop using the device if water or other material should penetrate inside: risk of fire and electrocution.
- Do not place heavy or heat-generating objects on top of the device: this could damage the casing and/or increase internal temperature causing faults.
- Keep magnets and magnetized objects away from the device to prevent faults.
- Wait for a while before operating a device after transporting it from a cold place to a warm place and vice versa. Wait on average for about three hours: this will allow the device to adapt to the new ambient (temperature, humidity, etc.).

The monitor is provided with a metal base and rubber feet. It can be positioned on a horizontal surface, such as a desk or a table. Make sure that the device is fastened firmly and that it is not resting on unstable supports or surfaces. Dropping could cause severe injury and damage the device.

Remember to adjust the brightness and contrast to obtain a perfect image.

CLEANING THE DEVICE

Use a dry cloth to remove dust and dirt. Dip the cloth in neutral detergent if dirt cannot be eliminated with a dry cloth alone. Do not use volatile liquids (such as petrol, alcohol, solvents, etc.) or chemically treated clothes to clean the device to prevent deformation, deterioration or scratches to the paint finish.

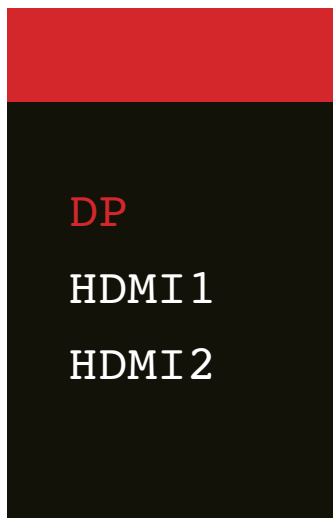
CONTROL PANEL



Monitor Button	Action

▲	Go up in the main OSD menu / increase the value of a selected item / open scene mode menu when OSD is not active.
E	Select signal source / exit OSD.
⏻	Power ON / OFF the monitor.

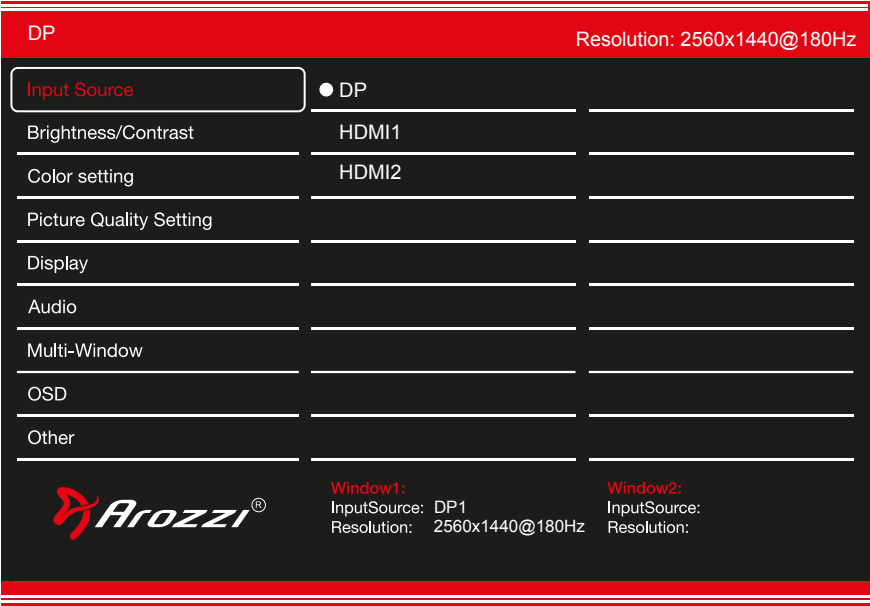
INITIAL SETUP

- Connect the monitor to a power outlet. Check mains rating before plugging the power unit in.
- Press the POWER button on the monitor to turn it on (The indicator will be blue).
- Connect the relevant image signal cable to the corresponding input on the monitor.
The source will be automatically detected.
- To change between inputs, press the “ E ” button to enter the source menu. Use the ▲ and ▼ buttons to choose the input source between DP, HDMI1 and HDMI2.
- If the monitor cannot find a signal on the chosen input, it will auto-select the input where a signal is present.



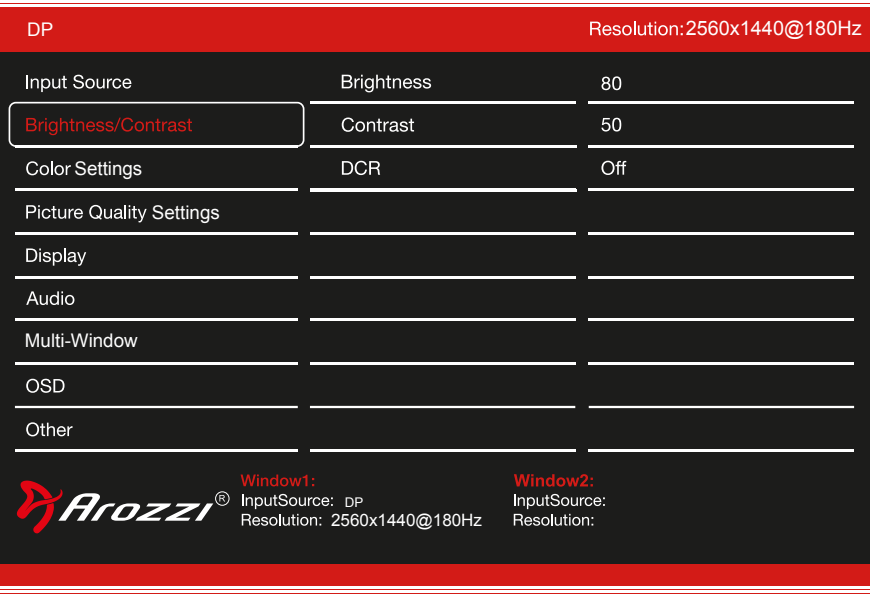
